The Clio City Park was dedicated in 1939 and is a popular destination for local residents. Clio City Park contains the Clio Amphitheater, Tacoma Falls, City of Clio Skatepark, and a portion of the George Atkin Jr. Recreational Trail. There are picnic areas, playground equipment, charcoal grills, and restroom facilities available for use throughout the park.

City of Clio Skatepark

The Skatepark is a 14,400 ft² facility located in the previous McCormick Ball Park between Center and Mill Streets. The Skatepark was made possible through \$30,000 in donations from the City of Clio, Vienna Township, and Thetford Township. Local businesses like Deke's Concrete and fundraisers also helped make the park possible.



George Atkin Jr. Recreational Trail

The George Atkin Jr. Recreational Trail is located along scenic Pine Run Creek in the City of Clio and Vienna Township. The eight foot wide 7.5 mile long concrete path is maintained throughout the year. This offers year-round recreational opportunities for bicyclists, runners, walkers, and roller-sport enthusiasts.

The path meanders through acres of natural woodlands, parks, residential and commercial areas linking Clio City Park to areas east, west, and south of downtown. Its most unique feature is uninterrupted travel across the local infrastructure through a series of tunnels and bridges. The path is easily accessible from parking lots which are located off Jennings, Wilson, and Neff Roads, as well as in the Clio City Park.

The trail is named after George Atkin Jr., a former Clio City Administrator. Atkin was instrumental in securing funds for the path in the mid-1980s.
