25 **City Administrator** – Wiederhold responded to the public comment regarding the snow clearing.

27 working to fill the vacancy.

28 **City Attorney** – reported that he pays for a snow clearing service for his city business, it is
29 necessary to clear your sidewalks in the winter.

33 **City Engineer-** Oparka reported the Watermain project bid opening will be held, Tuesday,
