34 **City Administrator** – Wiederhold had no further report. Commissioners asked about code
35 enforcement and Rogers Lodge clean-up.

36 **City Attorney** – no court activity

37 **Chief of Police** – Chief Rick Witham reported that ALICE training went well. The Active Shooter
38 training system is called A-L-I-C-E, using the acronym for Alert, Lockdown, Inform, Counter,
39 and Evacuate (ALICE). A-L-I-C-E typically trains students, faculty and staff to take a slightly
40 different approach. First, you alert the authorities of the situation by calling 9-1-1 based on what
41 the caller is witnessing. Other alerts may follow, such as the campus mass warning system.

42 Second, the people lock down in their affected area. Third, in a lockdown situation, inform others
43 of your plan if the shooter enters the area. Fourth, Counter – if the shooter enters the area, counter
44 with an attempt to escape or evacuate the area. If you are unable to evacuate and are trapped in an
45 area with an active shooter, then launch an offensive that disorients, disarms and surprises the
46 aggressor with any readily accessible objects (weapons) available. Lastly, evacuate
47 the area as soon as possible when so advised. Witham will be providing training for the
48 administrative staff next. Additionally, Chief Witham will be creating a podcast with the Clio
49 Middle School Assistant Principle.

50 **Treasurer** – absent

1 **City Engineer-** no report.

2 **DPS Superintendent-** Arnold spoke to the Commissioners about Emterra trash pickup being not
3 acceptable. Also, he is trying to stay on top of the potholes. It has been difficult with all the rain.
4 Brown is talking with MDOT Representative, Ponce Esparza about guardrail recycling. Brown
5 requested city identification badges for the workers. This will help the public identify city
6 workers.

7 **Clerk** – Kingston passed out Genesee County Recycle day posters to the Commissioners.
8 Hazardous Waste, Electronics, Paint and other materials will be set for drop off, May 12, 2018.
9 The City will post on their website as well. Reminder that daylight savings time is this weekend,
10 March 11, 2018.
