14 **8. Staff Reports**

15 **City Administrator** – Wiederhold mentioned sanitary sewer recommendation for 2020 will be
16 on next agenda. He reminded everyone why the shades are closed in the commission chambers,
17 Sgt. Urbina to report more during his report. No update on streetlights, is trying to setup a
18 meeting with McKerchie and Arnold.

19 **City Attorney** – reported he had court last week. Informed Commissioners on how frustrating it
20 can be to try and settle cases.

21 **City Treasurer-** asked Mayor Bare if she could get the Library Board budget numbers to him
22 when she receives them

23 **Chief of Police** – Interim Chief, Sam Urbina reported on an incident from April of 2018 which
24 involved residents from Campbell Street getting into a fight and one of them going in the home to
25 retrieve a gun. Another resident intervened and called the police. He is being charged with a
26 misdemeanor. This resident has been in front of the Commission before and has blamed the city
27 for losing one of his homes.

28 **City Engineer-** reported the contractor has requested a payout for the water main project; Dean
29 will work out a number. The road project is out to bid with the opening this week.

30 **DPS Superintendent-** reported that he has dealt with a few complaints regarding snow plowing.
31 Brown noted he prides himself on his work; Commissioners reinforced the great job he and his
32 crew are doing with the snow removal in the city. Meter pit is ready to go, need electricity to the
33 pit for a sump pump. Brown said everything is okay at the amphitheater, he has a heater in the
34 room with the sump pump, and no furniture was ruined.

37 **9. Commissioner comments/Committee reports**

38 **Commissioner Fejedelem-** attend the Parks & Rec meeting, they discussed the Zombie Walk
39 and how to deal with snow on the ice rink. Would like to see Parks & Rec maintain what we

41 **Commissioner Mosher** – loves the idea of the ice rink but there is a reason that other

3 **Mayor Bare** – Fire Authority approved the 2019-20 budget; made extra payment of the truck.
4 No fire runs in the city for January, Thetford had 1, Vienna 12 and 2 mutual assistance.
5 Firefighter Eric Cameron is back at Station 2 along with new Firefighter Mike Slattery.
6 Firefighter Mike McKervey is retiring with 25 years of service. Chief Paulson and Amy Wager
7 were invited to the Governor’s State of the State address and were hoping to influence some votes
8 for the Mike Wager memorial sign. Friend of the Library book sale made approximately \$1,300;
9 they were closed four days due to the weather but door count was still good. Roy is still working
10 on the Maker Space project; he will be applying for 3 grants that total around \$80,000. The grant
11 funds would be used for the Maker Space Project. Three of the six art students brought in their
12 art work on Friday to display at City Hall. The students participating this year include Rebecca
13 Siegers, Cassie Howard, Ashley Wirsing, Amber Bliss, Kendall Kearly, and Kiara Garza.
