**Treasurer's Report**

**Treasurer** Judy Campbell presented an abbreviated treasurer report. As of **February 28, 2026** the Amphitheater balance is **\$63,438.31**. This is in comparison to the balance at the end of **February, 2025** of **\$77,017.52**.

**Old Business**

**A) Update on Bat Removal – Bat Houses**

Craig Nelson reported a Clio Eagle Scout has been in contact with Craig about constructing bat houses in the Clio Park area to aid in keeping bats from living in the Amphitheater back stage.

**B) Update on Finishing Ticket Booth**

Craig Nelson reported he has not heard from the High School shop teacher about parts of the Ticket Booth that need to be finished. Craig will continue to work on this issue.

**C) Update on Changing Park Ordinance**

Neil Rankin reported the Amphitheater is no longer a part of the Clio Park.

**D) Agreement with Clio School for Parking Update**

Neil Rankin reported he has not had a response from Clio Schools regarding the use of the Middle School parking area for Amphitheater events.

### **E) Update on Amphitheater Season Pass Sales by High School Classes**

Judy Campbell reported Clio Schools has agreed to allow the High School classes to sell 2026 Amphitheater passes. The High School classes will earn \$5.00 for each pass sold.

### **F) Michigan Country Music Hall of Fame**

Craig Nelson reported the Michigan Country Hall of Fame is interested in possibly holding one of their events at the Clio Amphitheater. He will continue to work with the group to hopefully have the group perform at the Amphitheater this summer.

### **G) Sign Up for Amphitheater Volunteers**

Neil Rankin spoke about creating a list of volunteers for the 2026 season so volunteer training can be held for volunteers working in the ticket booth or back stage.

### **New Business**

#### **A) July 3 Genesee Concert Band Concert**

Doug Vance has been working with the **Genesee Concert Band** to have the Concert Band perform at the Amphitheater on **Friday, July 3<sup>rd</sup>** as a kickoff for the holiday. Doug would like the concert added to the

#### **B) Possibility of Food Trucks**

A discussion was held regarding the possibility of having **Food Trucks** at the Amphitheater concerts. At this time it was decided **not** to have food trucks as food trucks may cut into the Amphitheater concession profits.
