B. Public Hearing Road Diet Study – Proposed four- to three-lane conversion of South Mill Street in the City

Mayor Vance opened the public hearing at 6:01 pm

A Public Hearing for the purpose of taking public comments on the Road Diet Study –Rowe Professional Services Company was engaged to complete the road diet study for a proposed lane conversion from four lanes to three lanes on South Mill Street from the northbound approach of its intersection with Vienna Street to the southern city limits. This study concluded: The traffic analysis for a proposed road diet on South Mill Street between the southern city limits and the northbound approach of Vienna Street in the City of Clio, Michigan. Based on a review of the study area, crash analysis, and forecasted LOS comparisons, the proposed road diet would not negatively impact South Mill Street. Residents attended the meeting to voice their opinions on the road diet.

1. **Bonnie Fureigh on Hidden Creek Trl:** She asked about the traffic light which is not part of this road diet project. She did not comment on the road diet.
2. **Margaret Manser on Poplar Street:** She said she is all for the road diet but had concerns regarding traffic build-up near the school.
3. **Andrew Promenchenkel on N Mill Street:** He voiced concerns about the bike lane and having to walk on the road in bad weather when the sidewalks are not cleared. He commented that his Mother Cindy Promenchenkel would have been all for this project if she was still here.

Ryan Bair, PE of Rowe Professional Services Company along with Mayor Pro Tem Duane Mosher addressed most of the resident's questions or concerns with explanations.
