Old Business

A) Sesquicentennial Update

The Clio Amphitheater Board approved and sent to the Clio City Commission for final approval the motion to provide a seventh concert at the Amphitheater on **Wednesday, August 23**. The concert would be free to honor Clio's 150th anniversary as an established city. The motion, which was unanimously approved by all Clio Amphitheater board members, was to have the group, Persuasion, perform at a cost of \$2,000.00 and also to pay \$750.00 to Hyperman for sound and lights on August 23.

Judy Campbell reported Dairy Queen would be willing to make 150 ice cream treats that could be given free to concert goers. Reneé Wagle donated \$50.00 toward the cost of ice cream.

Doug Vance spoke about contacting other Clio civic groups for possible participation in the **Aug. 23** event.

New Business

A) Maintenance Issues - Bleachers

A discussion at the last two Clio Amphitheater meetings revealed unanimous support for removing the Amphitheater bleachers as they are in need of repair and could become unsafe. Eric Wiederhold will add this item to the Clio City Commission agenda and the bleacher seating will be blocked off for the 2023 season until they can be removed.

Amphitheater Readiness

1. Clear seating areas of leaves and debris
2. Attach flag mount to south side of building
3. Tape of or repair loose seats
4. Signs to close off bleachers
5. Post Amphitheater Rules signs at gates
6. Finish seeding and mulching main entrance gardens
7. Weed whack sidewalk weeds ad apply Round Up
8. Weed whack and rake up picnic area
9. Empty and place trash cans
10. Re-stripe steps and uneven cracks in sidewalks with yellow paint
11. Cut down and remove arbor vitae trees on north seating area
12. Cut grass and pick up leaves at old concession area
13. Check seating lights and tower lights
14. Call for port-a-john cleaning
15. Paint I-beam on stage and wood part of stage
16. Remove blue seats by Snack Shack to store under stage
17. Concert info on signs at Rogers Lodge Dr. and Clock Park
18. Move drum risers to center stage
19. Power wash tables
